Travel information Magic Resorts

We're excited to welcome you at our resort(s) soon! As a preparation for your stay with us, we'd like to share some practical information with you that might be useful. Please read this document carefully and if you have any remaining questions, feel free to contact us anytime – we're happy to answer all questions you may have.

Starting July 22, 2023, the Philippine government accepts all arriving international travelers regardless of their vaccination status!

First of all... Register your arrival through the E-travel pass.

For ALL travelers, no exceptions.

The Philippine government would like to receive some information from you prior your arrival to make the arrival procedures smoother.

- All arriving passengers are asked to register through etravel.gov.ph (free of charge) within 3 days before arrival.

Please have the following information ready, so it's easy for you to register:

- Your passport number;
- Your flight details;
- Residence details;

After you completed this form, you will get your QR-code - this code is required to enter the Philippines. Don't forget to save the code and/or make a print screen as a back-up.

Transfers: Cebu airport – Magic Island

If you're going to Magic Island and arrive in Cebu airport – please find your driver at the exit (outside) of the airport. He'll hold a signboard with our logo and/or your name, so it's easy for you to recognize him. Once you found him, take a seat in the vehicle and let the driver bring you to Magic Island in about 3 hours, depending on the traffic.

Transfers: Bohol airport – Magic Oceans

If you're going to Magic Oceans and arrive in Bohol airport – please find your driver at the exit (outside) of the airport. He'll hold a signboard with our logo and/or your name, so it's easy for you to recognize him. Once you found him, take a seat in the vehicle and let the driver bring you to Magic Oceans in about 2 hours, along the coast line of Bohol.

Transfers: Cebu airport – Magic Oceans

If you're going to Magic Oceans from Cebu airport – please find your 1st driver outside of the airport (holding a signboard with our logo and/or your name) and let him take you to the ferry port in about 40 minutes, depending on traffic. If we pick you up in a hotel in Cebu, the travel times depends on where you're staying.

Once at the ferry port, we have someone there to hand-over your ferry tickets. The ferry takes 2 hours. Please be advised that the aircon on the ferry works very well, it's a good idea to bring a jacket. Once in Tagbilaran, please make sure you have all your luggage and find your way to the exit of the port where our driver will be waiting for you. Take a seat and enjoy the view during the 2-hour drive to Magic Oceans.

NOTE: If your itinerary/package involves a ferry, please be advised to bring some small pocket money with you in local currency, to be able to pay small fees at the ferry port:

Ferry port Cebu City (Cebu)

* Please be advised that the use of porters is **not** mandatory.

Cash and money

At the airport in Cebu City, you can find several ATM's to withdraw money as soon as you arrive. The ATM's are located outside, on your left-hand side. In the airport (just before you exit), you can find a money exchanger, to exchange your cash into Philippine Peso. Furthermore, in Cebu City and Tagbilaran there are many ATMs to withdraw money. Most of the ATMs have a maximum amount of PHP 10.000 (± €160/\$188) at a time with a maximum of 2 withdrawals per day. There are several ATMs in Moalboal (Magic Island), but ATMs in Anda (Magic Oceans) are harder to find.

Paying at the resort

There are several ways to pay at both our resorts. We accept cash in American Dollars, Euros and Philippine Pesos. You can pay through online banking (don't forget to bring your details) or by credit card. Please note that there's a surcharge of 5% when you pay by credit card and the following cards are accepted:

Diving

If you bring your own dive suit, we advise to bring a 3 – 5 mm (long)suit. The water temperature varies between 26°C/78°F to 29°C/86°F. Our 12-liter/80 cubic feet aluminum tanks for air and Nitrox, have International as well as DIN connections.

We have a few 15-liter/100 cubic feet tanks available you may pre-reserve. The costs for the use of a 15L tank is PHP 450 per day, to be paid upon check out (not pre-bookable).

If you wish to dive with NITROX (and haven't pre-booked it), we'll add PHP 440 per NITROX-filling on your check-out bill.

Marine Protection Fee

In both Anda and Moalboal, there is a marine park/user fee to protect, keep up and improve our incredible reefs and marine life. In Moalboal, tickets are purchased for a fee of 100 pesos per dive (excl. VAT) and in Anda 300 pesos per day for divers (incl. VAT).

On each dive/snorkel session, the boat crew of Magic Island and Magic Oceans will take care of that for you and the total amount of the fees will be paid for upon check out. We greatly appreciate your support and co-operation. Conservation of the Philippines' spectacular marine habitats require funding, and your entrance fee is a valuable contribution to save the Philippine reefs.

Electronics

In the Philippines we have a 220Volt system and all our sockets are suited for European and American round or flat two pin plugs. For users of 110Volt chargers, we have a charging station in the restaurant where you can be sure to have only 110Volt. However, nowadays a lot

of chargers (for laptops and smartphones) can handle 100V – 240V. For electronics like hair dryers, it's another story. Luckily all our cottages have their own hair dryer!

Last but not least...

Don't forget to bring a good sunscreen and a mosquito repellent in case the mosquitos particularly like you.

Laundry services is available for a little charge, and you can enjoy FREE Wi-Fi (Starlink) throughout the resorts.

Please make sure that your passport is valid up to minimum of 6 months after your departure date.
